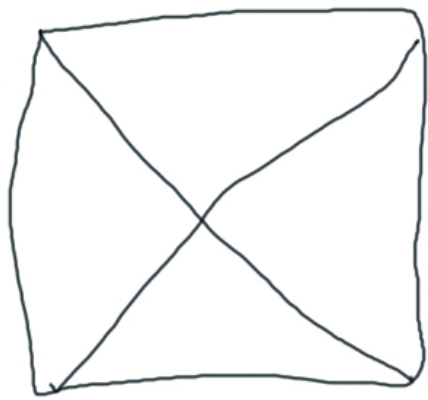
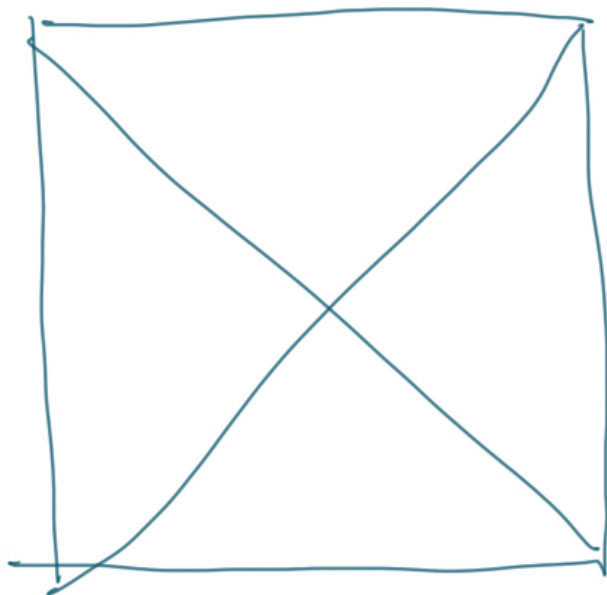


Start up Screen

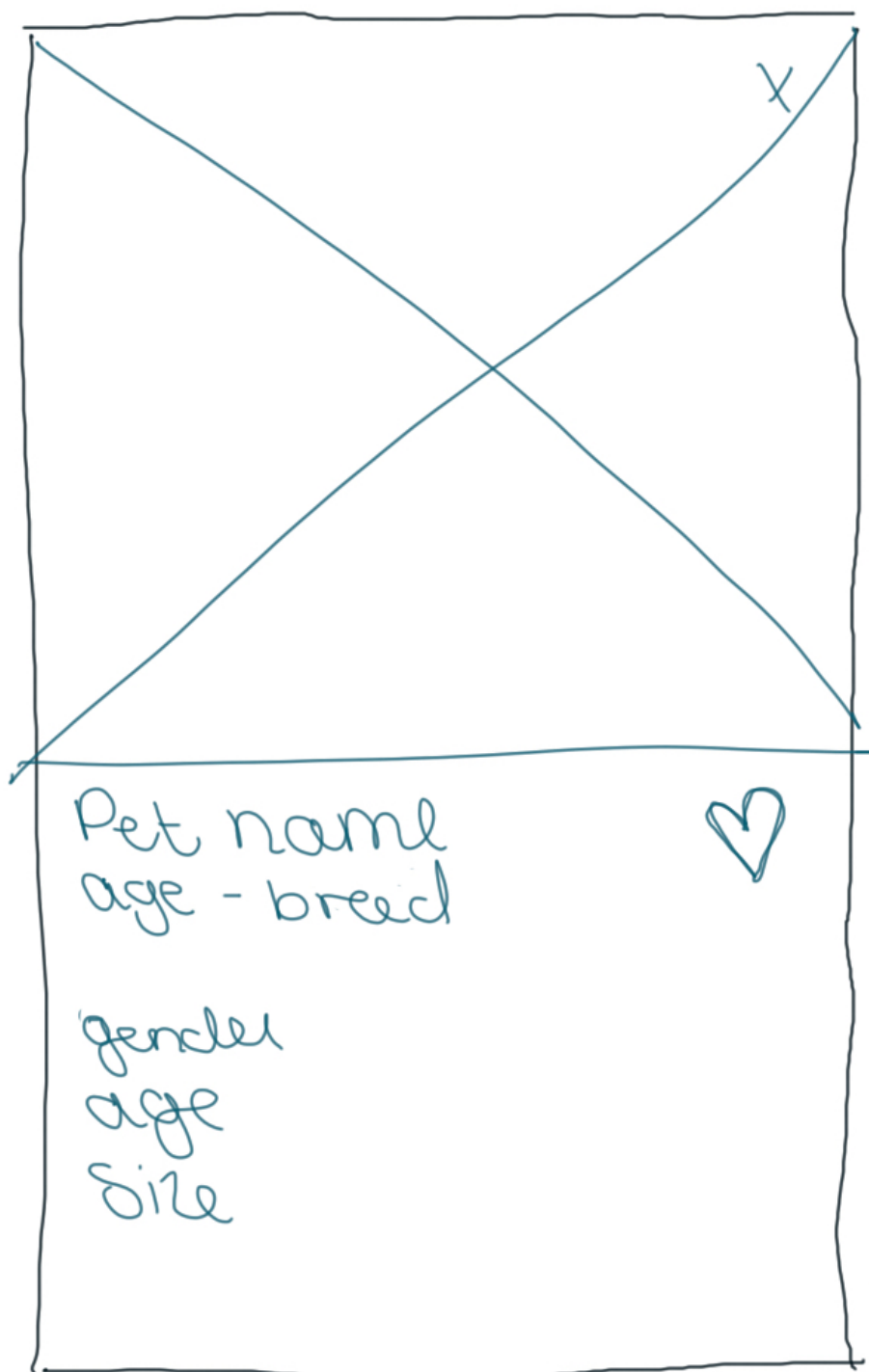


Home Screen

- This will be a Grid View automatically showing cards of eligible fosters matching your profile, which was set up when the user created an account

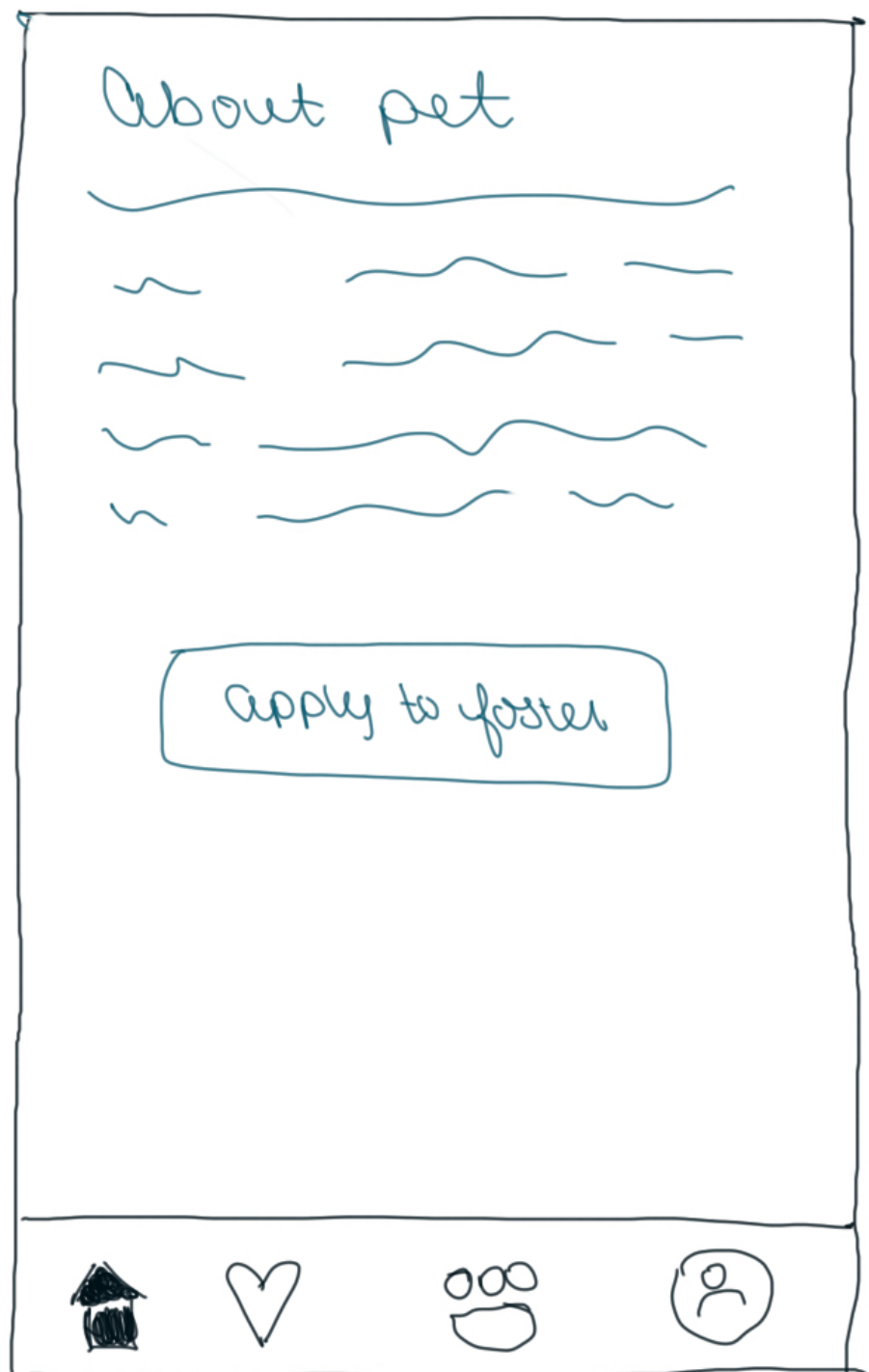

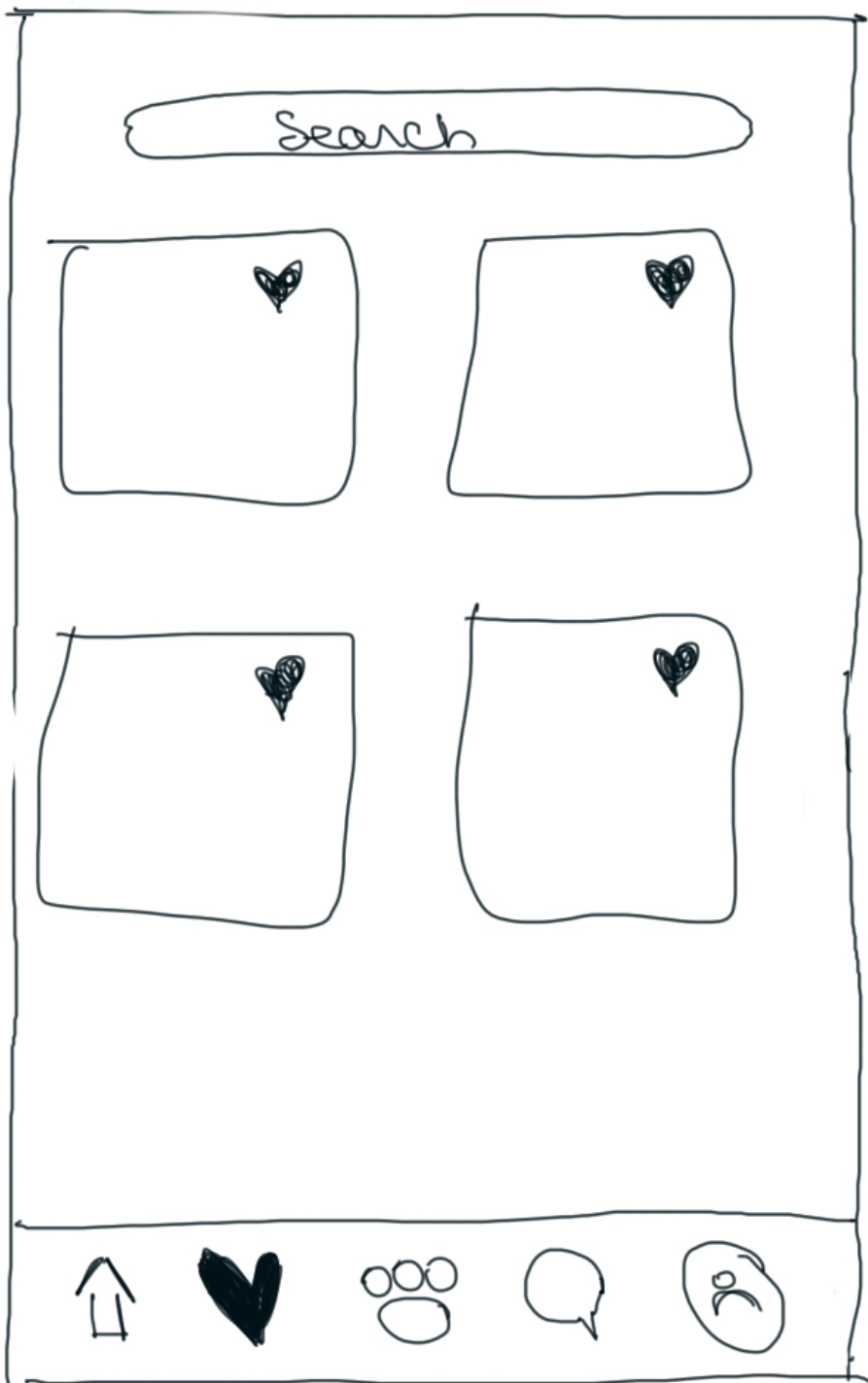


This will be a more in depth view of the pet

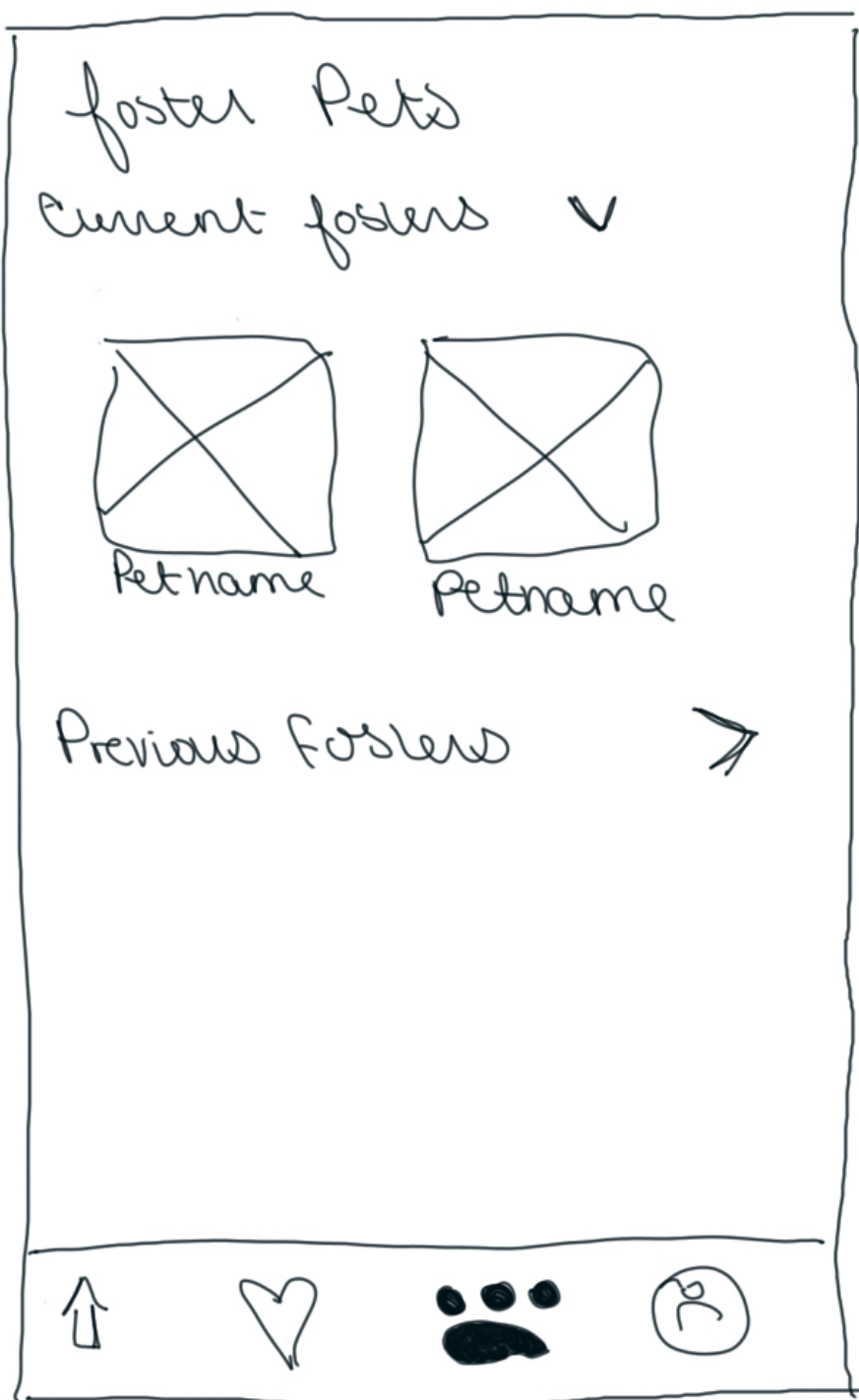
